## WNE Guide

WildLife Nature Experience is a nomadic nature immersion program open to children ages 4 to 9. Our philosophy accentuates our commitment to nature based learning. This is where learning occurs in the context of nature. Our staff consists of a Maryland certified teacher and a Master naturalist. All other degrees and certifications may be found on our website. During our time, children will learn through exploration and making hands-on discoveries. A typical summer day may consist of wading in the waters of the Chesapeake Bay, wildcrafting, exploring the forest, visiting a museum, or hiking.

## WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Drop off and pick up at Fountain Park: High Street Chestertown, MD 21620
- Teachers will transport children to the parks, space is limited.
- Adults may also drop off and pick up at the parks. The day for those not using WNE transportation runs from 9:30AM to 2:30PM (locations vary).
- We will be outside daily, rain or shine!
- Fully immersed outdoor experiences in a variety of natural spaces.
- Camps are not themed, however we follow a tentative daily schedule.
- Wildcrafting, art projects and other nature based crafts.
- Teachers will provide daily snacks and water refills as needed.

## WHAT TO BRING:

- A small backpack to carry their own belongings
  - reusable water bottle
  - change of clothes
  - bagged lunch
  - sunscreen and insect repellent each labeled with their name\*
- A hat to help protect them from the sun
- Closed-toed shoes for protection and safety that work in all weather/conditions
